1. SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT

a. Project Title: Composting

Bio-degradable waste mainly generated by the canteen is recycled through a process of composting. The waste is allowed to degrade or decompose an oxygen rich medium in a pit created behind the canteen. The matter is turned at regular intervals until it is reduced into a fine powder. This is a good quality nutrient rich and eco-friendly manure that is then used in the landscaped area.

(First party i.e. Institute of Design Education and Architectural studies, Nagpur hereinafter referred as IDEAS and second party i.e. Social Awareness and Action for Development hereinafter shall be called as SAAD)

WHEREAS, IDEAS - Institute of Design Education and Architectural Studies, Nagpur situated at Hudkeshwar road-Outer ring road junction point, Post Pipla, Nagpur, 440037 is an educational institute administering undergraduate and postgraduate degree in architecture and is promoted by Swargiya Jaganath Jattewar Shikshan Sanstha, Nagpur, District Nagpur – 440024 for architectural education purpose. IDEAS has since its inception, strived to develop an eco-friendly campus and sensitize its students to environmental issues.

WHEREAS, Social Awareness and Action for Development, Nagpur is a registered Non-Governmental Organization (NGO) working in Maharashtra with focus on environmental and natural resource management.

WHEREAS, in collaboration with SAAD, IDEAS will raise awareness on environmental issues with special focus on waste management and also develop a program to manage its wet kitchen waste.

WHEREAS, both parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MoU for advancing their mutual interest.

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SECTION II

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises set forth in this MOU, the parties hereby agree as follows:

CLAUSE 1 - OBJECTIVES

- 1.1 To raise awareness among all members of the Institute on the issue of solid waste management.
- 1.2 To develop a program for the management of wet kitchen waste generated in the Institute Canteen
- 1.3 To conduct seminars and workshops on the numerous methods for solid waste management for benefit of members of Institute and general public

CLAUSE 2 - IDEAS ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITES

- 2.1 IDEAS will look into recommendations given by SAAD for managing wet kitchen waste and initiate a program to incorporate the same
- 2.2 The Environment Committee will follow up on regular instructions given by SAAD for the running of the above mentioned program
- 2.3 IDEAS will provide a team of teaching staff and students to coordinate with SAAD in organizing awareness and teaching programs as agreed upon by both parties
- 2.4 IDEAS will bear the cost of holding any awareness and teaching programs that are held through mutual agreement including expert fees

CLAUSE 3 - SAAD ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITES

- 3.1 SAAD will provide expert knowledge for the setting up of a program to convert wet kitchen waste to compost
- 3.2 SAAD will aid the Institute in running the above said program by conducting regular inspections and providing necessary inputs
- 3.3 SAAD will source expert as and when required to conduct special seminars and workshops for knowledge sharing on solid waste management and related environmental issues
- 3.4 SAAD's representative will be a member of the IDEAS Environmental Committee

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CLAUSE 4 - JOINT ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

4.1 Both the parties agree upon the conduct of awareness and training programs for solid waste management once a year at IDEAS campus.

4.2 Both the parties will jointly finalize dates for various events at mutually convenient times

4.3 Both the parties will run a program to recycle and reuse wet kitchen waste generated on the IDEAS campus.

CLAUSE 5 - VALIDITY

5.1 This MOU is effective upon signature of both parties.

5.2 This agreement shall be valid until it is expressly terminated by either party on mutually agreed terms, during which period SAAD, the first party, as the case may be will take effective step for implementation of this MOU. Any act on the party of IDEAS, the second party, after termination of the this agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc. shall not be construed as an extension of this MOU

2. LIQUID WASTE MANAGEMENT

a. Project Title: DEWAT System

The waste water from toilets is passed through three stages before storage and is again filtered for reuse. **Stage 1- Sedimentation:** Waste water from the toilets on both floors is collected by a well-constructed drainage system leading to the closed septic tanks. There are two septic tanks. Each consists of two chambers, sedimentation takes place in first chamber.



Figure 3 Septic Tank

Stage 2- Anaerobic Filtration: The overflow from the septic tank is allowed to pass through an Effluent Treatment tank which has with four stages of filtration; i) Stone gravel; ii) Aggregate; iii) Sand and iv) Charcoal.

Stage 3- Aerobic Treatment: The final stage of treatment uses root zone system of aquatic plants. First the effluent is passed through three beds of duck weed and then two beds of water hyacinth. The treated water is allowed to stand in the last chamber to be disinfected by UV rays in sunlight.

Stage 4- Storage & Reuse: The treated water is again allowed to pass through a two-chamber filtration tank having sand and charcoal. This removes any dirt and plant matter. The water is then stored in an underground tank having capacity of 4500L. This tank is connected to a separate overhead tank which provides water for flushing in toilets.

- 3. Avoid use of disposable plates and cups in the canteen and café located on campus
- 4. Compost organic kitchen waste and use in landscaping


