

These work as storm water catchment and visible as an important architecture element of design. The walls appeared to be shaped land forms rising out of the earth, however the roof appears to be floating lightly above the sky line and provide ventilation . 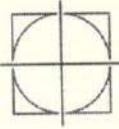



This memorandum Of Understanding (Hereinafter called as 'MoU') is entered on the 25TH day of May 2015 at IDEAS, Nagpur, Maharashtra

BETWEEN

Association of Consulting Civil Engineers (India). Nagpur Centre : Plot No.13/2, I.T. Park, Near VRCE Telephone Exchange, Parsodi, Nagpur-440022

AND

Institute of Design Education and Architectural studies, Nagpur (IDEAS) Swargiya Jagannath Jattewar Shikshan Sanstha, with its registered office at plot no.469, Tiranga chowk, Sakkardara, Nagpur

(First party i.e. Association of Consulting Civil Engineers hereinafter shall be called as ACCE and second party i.e. Institute of Design Education and Architectural studies, Nagpur hereinafter referred as IDEAS)

To run the "TRAINING IN FIELD PRACTICES FOR STUDENTS OF ARCHITECTURE" certificate program for students of architecture at IDEAS, Nagpur

- A) First party is ACCE - Association of Consulting Civil Engineers (India) which was formed and registered in 1985 by group of Consulting Civil Engineers in Bangalore. The main objective of the association is to encourage and foster the ideals of the profession.
- B) Second party, IDEAS - Institute of Design Education and Architectural studies, Nagpur situated at Hudkeshwar road-Outer ring road junction point, Post Pipla, Nagpur, 440037 is an educational institute administers under graduate and post graduate degree in architecture and is promoted by Swargiya Jagannath Jattewar Shikshan Sanstha, Nagpur, District Nagpur - 440024 for architectural education purpose.
- C) The parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of profession based training and education.
- D) Both parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MoU for advancing their mutual interest.

NOW THEREFORE IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1 - Cooperation

- 1.1 ACCE and IDEAS, Nagpur, both the parties shall explore, facilitate and adopt appropriate collaboration for said certificate program mutually discussed.
- 1.2 Eligibility for the participation in the program shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon for the students of institution.
- 1.3 Detail program content and duration will be proposed and discussed by both the parties (Irrespective of RTMNU i.e. Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University) to keep them under quality control and regulations.
- 1.4 Decisions regarding fees structure payment terms of each year shall be taken by mutual agreement of both the parties.

CLAUSE 2 - Scope of MoU

- 2.1 Both the parties agreed upon to conduct the said certificate program at IDEAS campus and institute is liable to provide required infrastructure for the same.
- 2.2 The arrangement of site visit and field visit, expert lectures and efforts required for smooth conduct of program shall be taken by ACCE.
- 2.3 IDEAS is liable to provide administrative support for admissions of students, fees collection, evaluation and to make provision of certificate for program.

CLAUSE 3 - Validity

- 3.1 This agreement shall be valid until it is expressly terminated by either party on mutually agreed terms, during which period ACCE, the first party, as the case may be will take effective step for implementation of this MoU. Any act on the party of IDEAS, the second party, after termination of the this agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc. shall not be construed as an extension of this MoU.

3.2 Both parties may terminate this MoU upon 30 calendar days notice in writing. In the event of termination, both parties have to discharge their obligation

CLAUSE 4 - Relationship between the parties

4.1 It is expressly agree that ACCE and IDEAS are acting under this MoU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MoU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither party is authorized to use the other party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligations or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of other party, without the prior written consent of the other party. Neither party shall have nor represent itself as having, any authority under the term of this MoU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other party, to pledge the other party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other party.




