


I CAN BE AN ARCHITECT WORKSHOP SERIES 2021

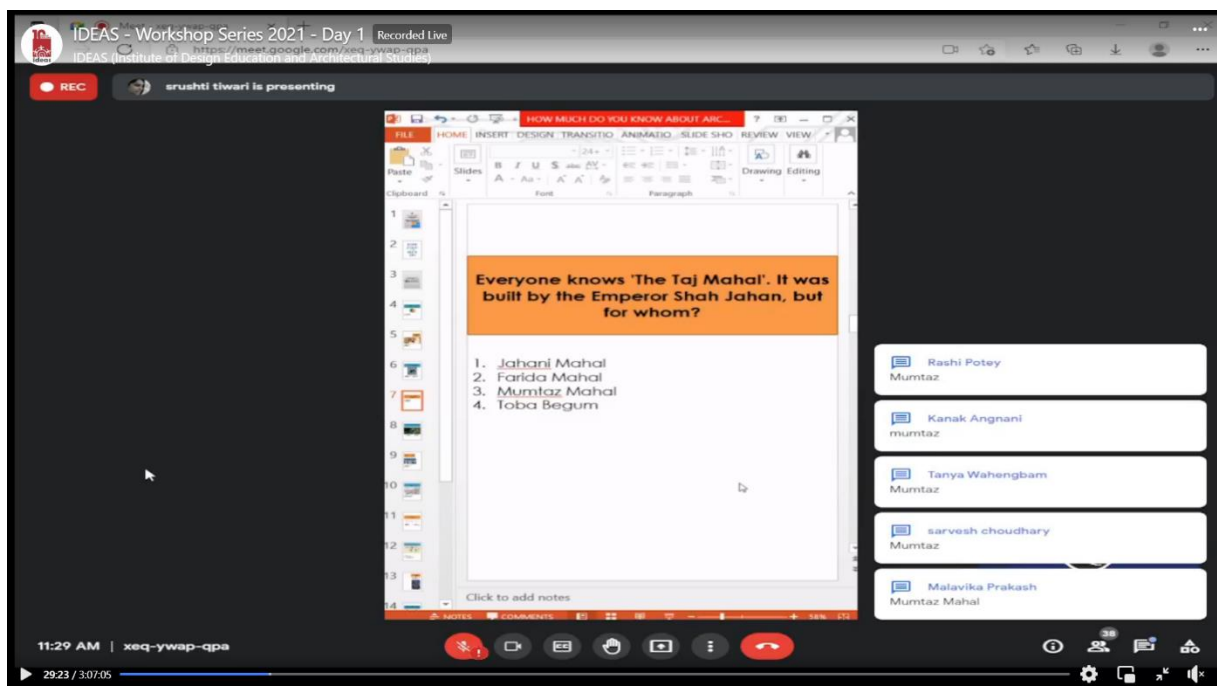
Prof. Purohit began the webinar by welcoming all present and giving an overview of the workshops planned for the week.

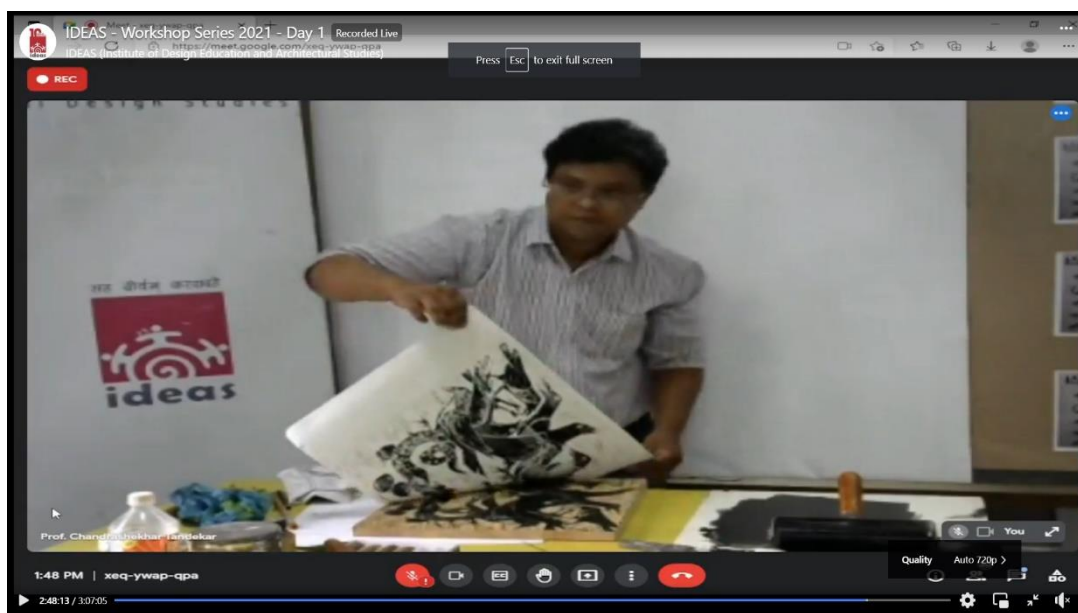
Prof. Gadkari spoke to the students about the importance of having an aptitude for architecture as well as the right aptitude

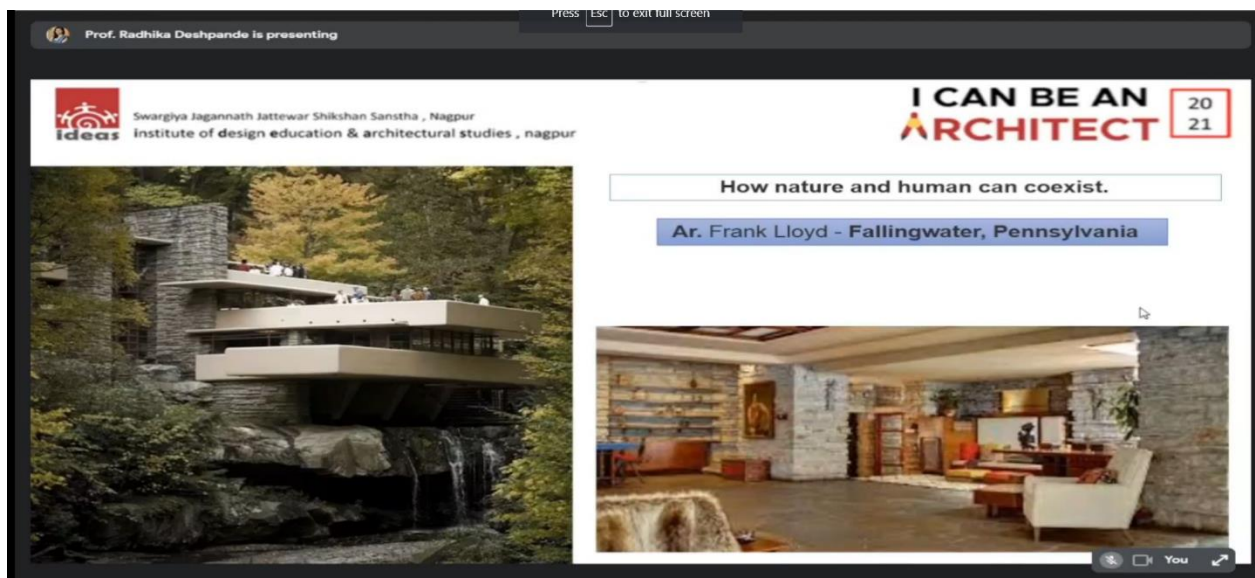

Topic of Workshop: Structures in Architecture

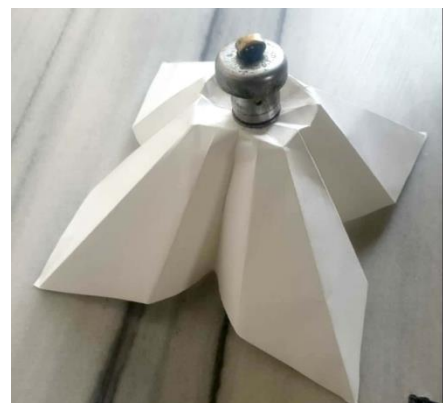

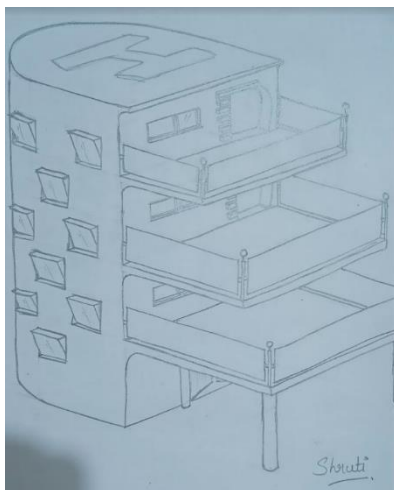
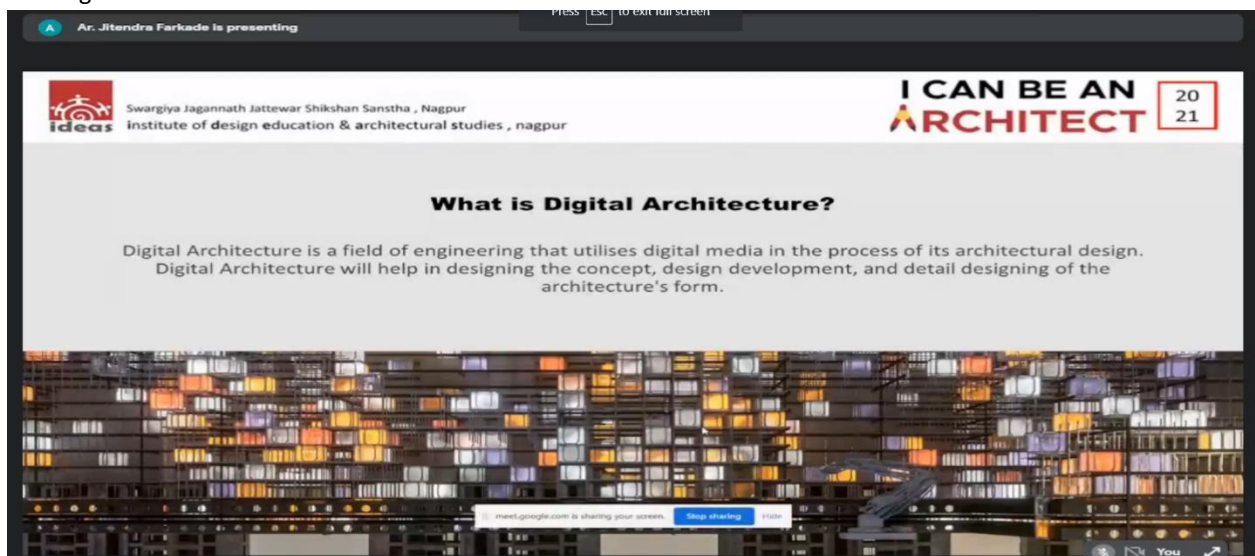
Topic of Workshop: Digital Architecture

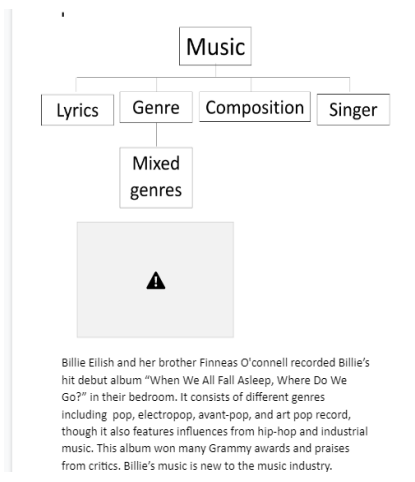

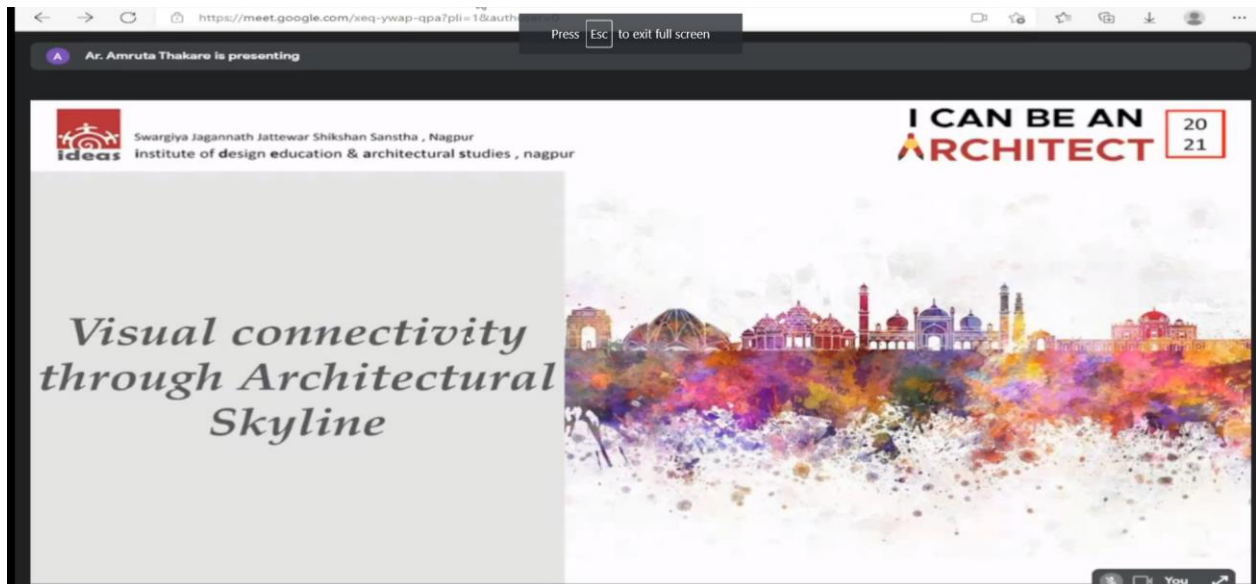
Prof. Mankar highlighted the Institutes excellent academic performance. He also talked about structures as a subject of study in architecture.

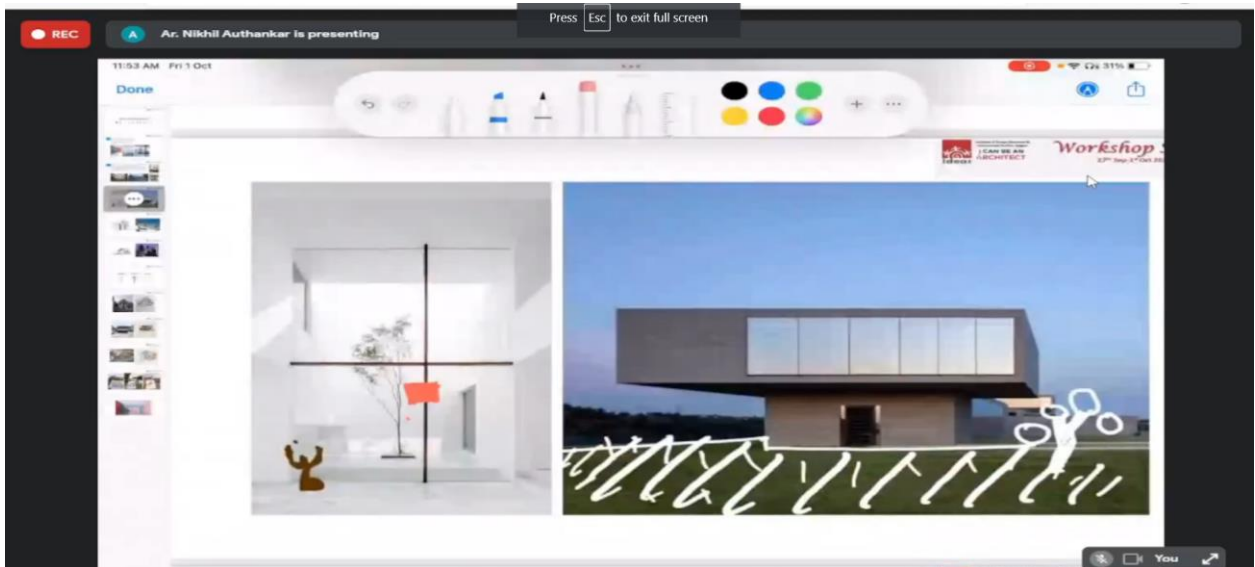
Prof. Kimmatkar brought out the difference of architectural education at IDEAS. At the Institute students are encourage to explore and innovate through self-learning with the support of mentors.
